HELPS Small Group Training Overview

Classroom teachers have limited time to offer one-on-one instruction. Therefore, in 2012, HEF developed and evaluated a HELPS Small Group program that can be used with a group of 3-6 students. HELPS has appeared in numerous peer-reviewed scholarly publications evidencing its effectiveness. In short, research shows that HELPS improves students' reading fluency and comprehension in significant ways.

Teachers who are already implementing HELPS SG are encouraged to participate in this training.
